10. A participant can choose any **TWO** topics from cluster I and any **ONE** topic from cluster II. (NOT EXCEEDING THREE TOPICS IN TOTAL)
OR
A participant can choose any **ONE** topic from cluster I and any **TWO** topics from cluster II. (NOT EXCEEDING THREE TOPICS IN TOTAL)
11. Each student is allowed to participate maximum in **THREE** items.
12. Individual points of prize winners will be added to their house to decidethe House Champion 2023-24
13. The presentation of team / student members' shows a deep understanding of the project and its active contribution to it.
